#### **COLLEGE RULES & REGULATIONS**

SDMIT framed college rules & regulations to protect the rights, interests, and safety of the students and college community by large. They cover areas deemed essential for maintaining an environment conducive to carrying out studies. Within the framework established in these regulations, the individual is as free as possible to conduct his/ her own academic and non-academic life.

Students have the right to freedom of inquiry and are expected to know and adhere to the standards of academic integrity. However, the privilege of making independent decisions involves the acceptance of responsibility should such choices violate the regulations. Therefore, the college expects students to always uphold standards of personal and social conduct when they are associated with SDMIT and assumes that individual decisions will be accompanied by careful consideration of the standards maintained by the community.

### The expectations:

- Wishing staff at college or hostel by saying 'good morning or good afternoon' is a positive and welcoming attitude of a student. This simple act is a form of basic courtesy and etiquette, and demonstrates several positive attributes like respect, politeness, good communication, etc.
- Students are expected to use courteous and polite language and behave with decorum when talking to the teachers and staff of the college and hostel
- Wear clean and tidy clothes, appropriate footwear/ shoes, maintain hygiene, look well-groomed and appear in professional attire.
- Participate actively in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities which helps to build essential life skills like leadership, teamwork, time management, confidence & creativity, improve academic focus, foster social skills, and promote holistic development.

### **Identity Card:**

Every student must possess an identity card with his/ her photograph affixed on it, duly attested by the principal. All students must wear ID cards around neck in the college campus, classrooms, laboratories, examination halls, library, office, cafeteria, etc. and are required to use them as ID proof while:

- Borrowing books from the College library
- Appearing for examinations
- Submitting applications/ request letters, receiving the payment of scholarships, etc., at the college office/ availing concession tickets to travel by bus, rail or air.
- Representing the college in seminars, workshops, sports, etc. at other colleges.
- Produce the ID card when staff/ wardens/ security personnel demand for verification
- Advised to carry ID cards always while travelling as an identity proof as it may help in case of any emergency/ using postal and bank services

If the ID card is lost, immediately report to the HoD and college office, and apply for a new ID card. Returned the old ID card to the college office, if found.

- Students should avoid using insulting, inciting, threatening language
  when talking with fellow students and should totally avoid violence.
  Students should not talk or act in any manner outside the institutions in
  a way that would bring disrepute and tarnish the image of the
  institution.
- Students shall wear clean and tidy uniform on prescribed days. They are not allowed to wear T-shirts with slogans / collar-less T-shirts and ripped/ faded jeans/ tight fits/ etc.
- The use of cell phones in classrooms or during class hours anywhere within the college premises is strictly prohibited. The cell phone may be confiscated if a student is found using the same anytime between 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- Students are expected to be regular and punctual in attending classes and all activities connected with the college.
- Students should be seated at the lecture halls 5 minutes before the commencement of classes and raise from the seats during the prayer.
- Gathering in groups at roads, entrance, exit, pathways, gardens etc. is strictly prohibited.
- On entering the class, they shall observe silence, irrespective of the presence or absence of the teacher.
- They shall get up quietly as the teacher enters the class and keep standing till the teacher asks them to be seated.
- No student is permitted to leave the class room during class hours.

- Office will be kept open during lunch time to enable students paying fee, applying for certificates, scholarships, etc.
- Students are expected to read notices/circulars displayed on the college notice board regularly every morning and evening. Ignorance of not reading any notice/circular thus displayed shall not be accepted as an excuse failing to comply with the directions contained in it.
- All vehicles should be parked in the allotted place. Vehicles found parked in unauthorized places shall be impounded.
- Students who bring vehicles should possess valid driving license, insurance, and vehicle records.
- Student 2- wheelers are allowed and must be parked at left and right side of the main gate.
- 2- wheeler riders must wear helmets and no more that 2 members should travel.
- Student 4-wheelers are not allowed into the campus.
- While attending college functions, the students shall behave well manner way and maintain good etiquettes.
- Students will promptly stand to solemn attention when prayer or National Anthem is being played.
- Spitting, smoking and throwing bits of paper inside the college campus are not civic and therefore must be avoided.
- Students are not supposed to enter the college office and the staff rooms during unspecified hours.
- Damaging the building or furniture in any way is strictly prohibited.
  The cost of any damage so caused will be recovered from the
  students collectively if the responsibility for it cannot be fixed on any
  individual or group of individuals.
- Representation of complaints and grievances may be made individually to the principal/grievance redress cell/ suggestion box.
- Students are strictly forbidden from engaging themselves in any political or other movements, strikes/protests, etc.
- No meeting of any kind shall be held in the college premises without the written permission of the principal.
- No notice of any kind shall be circulated among students or displayed on black boards or on notice board without the written permission of the principal. No information or report should be sent to press or board casting agencies without the permission and approval of the principal.
- No collection of money/ raising contributions/ etc. without proper information to the principal and without the permission.

- Help to maintain the beauty, serenity and greenery of the campus.
- Avail the dust bin facility.
- Pasting of wall posters, writing on walls and roads are prohibited.
- Although the university prescribes a minimum of 85% of attendance, the college insists on regular attendance in all classes.
- The concerned committee decision and the principal's decision shall be the final in all matters of punishment of the students for violation of any of the rules and regulations of the college.

#### CAUTION ON RAGGING

The Government of Karnataka has made ragging a cognizable offence punishable with imprisonment and holds the principal responsible for making the college ragging free. Under the direction of the Supreme Court of India, authorities have asked colleges to take necessary measures to prevent ragging. Students are severely warned that

Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited by law inside the campus and outside. Offenders will be dismissed from college and the Hostel or withheld from appearing university examinations.

• Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be one or any combination of the following:

- Cancellation of admission/ suspension from attending classes/ expulsion from the college/ hostel
- Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits/ monetary penalty/ etc.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime or ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
