The Department of Civil Engineering procured a Non-Destructive Testing (NDT) instrument under consultancy work, which is capable of analyzing the compressive strength of hardened concrete. The Rebound Hammer Test, a semi-automatic instrument manufactured by Labline, is a non-destructive method used to assess the surface hardness and estimate the compressive strength of concrete. It determines the concrete's strength quality by measuring the rebound of a spring-driven hammer mass impacting its surface.

Training and Placement

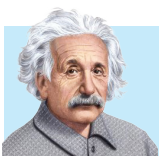
- SDMIT's Training and Placement Cell organized the following pre-placement training programs (in association with the training partner DLithe):

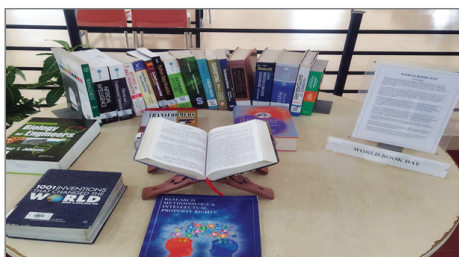

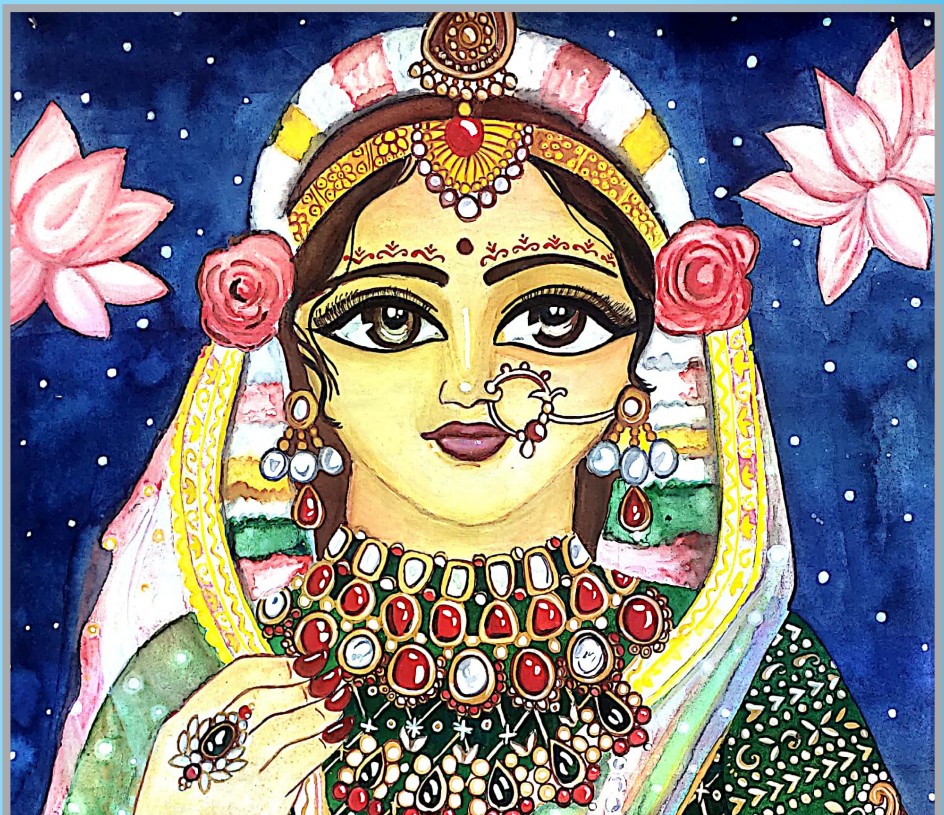
